School registration for 2011-12

Classes begin

Grades 2-12 – Aug. 16, 2011
Grades PreK-1 – Aug. 22, 2011

Students must pay all fines and charges from the 2010-11 school year before they can pick up their class schedule.

New-to-ASD students must have:

- Proof of residency, such as a utility or phone bill, contract of purchase or lease agreement.
- Current official record of immunization:
 - Diphtheria, pertussis and tetanus
 - Polio
 - Measles, mumps and rubella
 - Hepatitis A
 - Hepatitis B
 - Varicella (two doses are required for K-6)
- Copy of birth certificate for kindergarten and first-grade students.
- Physical examination for kindergarten students. Statement must be completed by a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or state authorized advanced nurse practitioner.
- Copies of legal papers if there is a custody agreement.
- Unofficial transcripts from former school for high school students.

All students transferring into the district will receive a health screening by a school nurse within 90 days, to meet the physical examination requirement.

Students attending an ASD preschool are required to register and be immunized. Students may register, but will not be allowed to attend classes until the shot record is on file.
