

### **Radio spot 1**

The Anchorage School District educates more than 49,000 students. That's nearly 37 percent of all children statewide.

That many students require a lot of space. That's why ASD has the largest physical plant in Alaska with 99 schools and support facilities.

More than half of the school buildings are between 20 and 50 years old.

This year alone, the district will spend \$22.5 million from the general fund budget to maintain these buildings.

But for big ticket renovation projects... the district bonds for funding. This is kind of like when homeowners get a loan to replace their roof or install a new boiler.

Bond propositions 1 and 2 will fund renewal projects at 25 school facilities and one future school site.

Prop 1 and 2 projects include school additions, renovations roof replacements, electrical, mechanical and traffic safety projects.
