The Anchorage School District has 99 school facilities.

To keep those buildings up to par we'll spend \$22.5 million in maintenance this school year alone.

On April 7, there will be two school bonds totaling \$93.7 million in school construction projects on the ballot.

If you think about it, there are two ways to pay for the projects...bond for the money or include the projects in the district's budget.

If that money is put in the budget that's \$93 million less for educational programs.

If that money is bonded...

The state will pay for the majority of project costs through the debt reimbursement program...and the community will be left to pay less than half of the bill.
