Nearly 40 years after it was built, Service High School is stuck in the middle of a major construction project.

Half of the school's renovation is done... the other half, which equals the size of three elementary schools, is in voters' hands.

Proposition 1 provides \$66.7 million to complete construction at Service High School.

The project qualifies for debt reimbursement, so upon legislative appropriation, local property owners will only pay forty cents on the dollar for the project.

When it comes to square footage, Service high is bigger than the new Dena'ina Convention Center, the Egan Center and the Sullivan Arena combined.

It's a big construction project that will employ a lot of people if approved by voters.
