

Shortcut Keys for Running a Slide Show

PC Users	
F5	Begin slide show
Esc or hyphen (-)	Ends slide show
Page number+Enter	Takes you to that slide
Right Mouse Click	Pop-up menu/previous slide
A or equal sign (=)	Show/Hide the arrow pointer
B or period (.)	Displays a black screen or return to the slide show from a black screen
E	Erase drawing on screen
H	Go to hidden slide
M	Rehearse – advance on mouse click
N, left arrow, spacebar, right or down arrow, enter or page down	Advance to the next slide or animation
O	Rehearse – use original time
P, backspace, left or up arrow or page up	Return to the previous slide or animation
S or plus sign (+)	Stop/Restart automatic slide show
T	Rehearse – use new time
W or comma (,)	Displays a white screen or return to the slide show from a white screen
Ctrl+A	Change pointer to arrow
Ctrl+H	Hide pointer and button
Ctrl+M	Show/hide ink markup
Ctrl+P	Change pointer to pen
Ctrl+S	All slides dialog
Ctrl+T	View Task Bar
Ctrl+U	Automatically show/hide arrow

Mac Users	
Ctrl+click mouse button	Pop-up menu
Ctrl+H	Hide pointer and button
Esc, ⌘+period (.) or hyphen (-)	Ends slide show
Page number+Enter	Takes you to that slide
A or equal sign (=)	Show/Hide the arrow pointer
B or period (.)	Displays a black screen or return to the slide show from a black screen
E	Erase drawing on screen
H	Go to hidden slide
M	Rehearse – advance on mouse click
N, left arrow, spacebar, right or down arrow, enter or page down	Advance to the next slide or animation
O	Rehearse – use original time
P, backspace, left or up arrow or page up	Return to the previous slide or animation
S or plus sign (+)	Stop/Restart automatic slide show
T	Rehearse – use new time
W or comma (,)	Displays a white screen or return to the slide show from a white screen
⌘+A	Change pointer to arrow
⌘+P	Change pointer to pen
⌘+U	Automatically show/hide arrow
