

American Revolutionary War Culminating Assessment

Students will answer the following question: What tensions were inherent prior to and during the Revolutionary War? What were the causes and results to these tensions?

“Think, Pair, Write, Share” structure: Given 5 minutes, students will think about their own thoughts to the questions above. Students will share their thinking to the question with their shoulder partner, and write their answer down on their own paper. Finally the students will share their thinking with the team.

Team Statement: Given the four different answers students came up with, the team should synthesize a team statement to answer the questions with pictures. Students will share the team statement with the class and be able to defend their thinking.

Rubric:

5 points – Students will need to list and describe at least 5 main events, people, and recognize 3 points of tension in America at this time. Adequate spelling, grammar usage and mechanics are required.

3 points - Students will need to list and describe at least 3 main events, people and recognize 2 points of tension in America at this time. Adequate spelling, grammar usage and mechanics are required.

1 point – Students will need to list and describe at least 2 main events, people and recognize 1 point of tension in America at this time. There is little effort in spelling or grammar usage and mechanics.
