Poster

For the next two weeks, you will be creating a poster about one of your classmates. Each activity is worth points. To receive full credit for activities, they must be neat, complete, and edited.

Required Activities:

1. Draw or obtain a photo of your partner. It needs to be a recent photo. I am sure your partner was an adorable baby, but the picture must resemble the subject of the biography.
2. Write 3-5 paragraphs describing them. You may include information about your family, hobbies, talents, special interests, habits, traditions- whatever makes them special.
3. Have them plan their perfect day. The appropriateness of the activities would be the only object. Money is not. Remember that there are 24 hours in the day.
4. Include 5 quotes, song titles/lyrics that represent them. (They should pick them.)
5. Write a list of their 10 most unique characteristics.
6. Have them tell you the story of how they got their name. If there is no "story," find out the meaning of each name. Ask the question: Do you think your name "fits" you or would you like to change it?

Partner Interview

This interview is the basis for the 3-5 paragraph paper on your partner. These questions are a guide to help you get started. If you have more questions that are not listed here, feel free to ask them.

1. How long have you lived in this community?
2. What other places have you lived? Which one was your favorite?
3. List 3 things you like about living here.
4. Are there any things you DON'T like about living here?
5. What do you like to do for fun? (at least 3)
