Pick a Name

Students put on name tags. Have each student write his name on a card and put it into a basket. Choose one student to pick a card from the basket and deliver it to the person whose name appears on the card. Each introduce himself. and the one whose name appears on the card picks the next name.

Have students form a circle. Have the game starter begin with, "My name is Paul and I like _____." The student to the left says, "His name is Paul and he likes _____. My name is Jean and I like _____." Continue around the circle. This memorization technique works well within academic topics that require a lot of repetition to be learned.
