

## Silhouette Collage

1. Use an overhead projector as a light source and sit students one at a time near the light so the outline casts a shadow on the wall.
2. Trace the outline on white construction paper with a pencil and have the student cut it out.
3. The student should then use the silhouette as a pattern and trace around it in pencil on a piece of black construction paper.
4. Challenge students to find pictures from magazines which represent their interests to place as a background on the outside of the silhouette. The black paper surrounding the silhouette should disappear if the student has really created a collage.
5. Glue the white silhouette onto the black paper/collage.
6. Challenge the student to find words and phrases from magazines/newspapers which describe them. These should be glued directly on the white silhouette.
7. Students should print out their name in size 48 font on the computer and glue to the center of the white silhouette.
