

September Snowball Fight

Have students write down three things about themselves on a piece of white paper, scrunch it up in a ball, and then for a minute or two have a snowball fight!

When you signal stop, everyone picks up a snowball and reads the information. Then they go and find that person.

Variation: Use this as a summarization activity. After students participate in a lesson, have them record three pieces of new information that they learned. Because of the snowball fight, they have the opportunity to hear a partner's new learning, too.
