SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT AWARD: MCLAUGHLIN BUS
SHELTER PROJECT

ASD Goal: Establish and maintain a supportive and effective learning environment by collaborating with other community agencies to maximize opportunities for lifelong learning.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the School Board approve and authorize the Superintendent to accept a grant award for McLaughlin High School from the Municipality of Anchorage in the amount of \$31,900. These funds will be used for the McLaughlin Youth Center Bus Shelter Project.

PERTINENT FACTS:

This is a continuation of funding to the Anchorage School District for McLaughlin youth to clean the Municipality of Anchorage's bus shelters. McLaughlin youth have participated in this project for the past 15 years. Grant funds will be used to fund non-certificated personnel to oversee the grant and supervise youth who clean the shelters. Youth will also receive reinforcements, such as food and drinks, for their services.
