SUBJECT: SCHOOL BOARD POLICY REVISIONS: SECTION 165.2
REGULAR MEETINGS (SECOND READING)

ASD Goal: Ensure public accountability through... effective communication with students, staff, parents, community and government at all levels.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve on Second Reading the recommended policy change for School Board Policy 165.2 Regular Meetings.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The Policy subcommittee voted unanimously at the September 15, 2005 School Board Policy subcommittee meeting for the proposed change in Regular Meetings -165.2. School Board unanimously approved the recommended changes at their meeting on October 10, 2005

Clarification of the definition of regular meetings was added in the first sentence of policy 165.2. This addition stipulates that the School Board shall meet on the second and fourth Monday of each calendar month, "unless rescheduling of the regular meeting is required." This language is to allow for a regular School Board meeting to be rescheduled without having to call the meeting a "special meeting."

165.2 Regular Meetings

The Board shall meet on the second and fourth Monday of each calendar month at the time advertised by the Board, unless rescheduling of the regular meeting is required. Items not on the agenda may be taken up by a majority vote of the Board and placed on the agenda of a future meeting of the School Board. Five votes are required for the item to be placed on the agenda at that current meeting.
