ASD Goal: *Maintaining a supportive and effective learning environment.*

PERTINENT FACTS:

Twenty one years ago the Crayola Dream-Makers Award program was introduced to encourage the creativity and conceptual development of kindergarten through sixth-grade children through art activities emphasizing the value of visual learning in all curricular areas, and calling attention to the creative work of children through exhibitions of their artwork. Artwork submissions reflect cross curricular context, including art and literacy, art and math and art and science. The artwork was judged on the basis of visual appeal, originality, craftsmanship, and the student's statement about his or her work.

Eleven elementary students from the Anchorage School District were among the 40 selected from the Western Region to receive awards. The winning students are Hattie Williams of Fairview, Moe Liaga and Daniel Walton formerly of Fairview, Cassandra Munoz of Chester Valley, Lisa Torres of Rabbit Creek, Pierce Bateman, Anna Roller, Rebecca Hanscam and Fiona Bruce of O'Malley, and Kira Egelhofer and Zoe Ingram-Patton formerly of O'Malley.

These creative students received valuable guidance and support from art teachers Hollis Mitchell of Rabbit Creek and O'Malley, and Sharon Trager of Fairview and Chester Valley.

It is requested the School Board recognize these award-winning students and their teachers for their artistic achievements.
