SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT AWARD: MCLAUGHLIN BUS
SHELTER PROJECT

ASD Goal: Establish and maintain a supportive and effective learning environment by providing safe, caring, and barrier-free schools; promoting health and wellness; continuing to retain, recruit, and train highly qualified staff; challenging each student academically; maximizing opportunities for lifelong learning; offering reinforcing extracurricular activities; and collaborating with other community agencies to maximize opportunities for lifelong learning.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve and authorize the Superintendent to accept a grant award for McLaughlin Secondary School from the Municipality of Anchorage in the amount of \$31,900.

PERTINENT FACTS:

This is a continuation of funding to the Anchorage School District for McLaughlin youth who qualify for off-center release to clean the Municipality of Anchorage's bus shelters. It has been noted that since the McLaughlin youth have participated in this project during the past years, the Muni Bus shelters have been vandalized less, therefore benefiting both the McLaughlin youth and the Municipality of Anchorage. This money will be used to fund non-certificated personnel through Special Activity Agreements to oversee the grant and supervise youth who clean the shelters. Youth will also receive reinforcements, such as food and drinks, for their services.
