SUBJECT: APPROPRIATION OF STATE OF ALASKA LEGISLATIVE
GRANT FUNDS SENATE BILL 53

ASD Goal: Ensure public accountability through effective consultation with community to ensure wise use of financial resources and responsible construction and maintenance of facilities.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board accept from the State of Alaska grant appropriations funded by Senate Bill No. 53 in the total amount of \$5,720,300 (Attachment A).

PERTINENT FACTS:

During the First Session of the Twenty-Fifth Legislature, the Alaska State Legislature approved Senate Bill No. 53, appropriating 48 grants to the Anchorage School District in the total amount of \$5,720,300.

All grants are appropriated through the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development to the Municipality of Anchorage on behalf of the District.

Assembly Resolution 2007-153(S) was introduced to the Anchorage Assembly on July 17, accepting and appropriating 2008 State of Alaska Legislative Grants per Senate Bill 53 after Governor Palin's final veto. A public hearing was scheduled on the same day.
