SUBJECT: NOMINATION FOR AASB BOARD OF DIRECTORS

ASD Goal: *Establish and maintain a **supportive and effective learning environment** by collaborating with other community agencies to maximize opportunities for lifelong learning.*

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the School Board nominate Crystal Kennedy for a seat on the Association of Alaska School Boards' Board of Directors.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The Association of Alaska School Boards (AASB) is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of 15 members elected at large from throughout the state. To qualify for a seat on the Board, a nominee must be a member of a Board of Education in good standing with the Association.

The criteria for selection include demonstrated leadership and experience, a perspective and vision of the future for school boards, adaptability, and the time to devote to AASB Board service.

Aside from expected participation in AASB activities, members of the Board of Directors establish policies that supervise, control and direct the business of AASB. Adopting and maintaining a Board Policy Manual, which sets forth procedures and guidelines for the Board's operations, is also a corporate duty of selected individuals.

Crystal Kennedy's proven dedication to fulfilling her role and responsibility as a member of the Anchorage School Board is apparent. Ms. Kennedy cares about the educational welfare of Alaska's public school students and is committed to improving education for the entire State of Alaska.
