RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve and authorize the Superintendent to accept a cash grant from the Alaska Community Foundation for Family Math Nights, in the amount of \$5,000.

PERTINENT FACTS:

In support of encouraging parents to better understand and to take part in the math curriculum that is being taught to their children, the Alaska Community Foundation has granted \$5,000 to the ASD Math Department to help support Family Math Nights in the elementary schools. Funds will support parent outreach, family workshop materials, and hands-on math materials for families to take with them to use at home to reinforce the math that their children learn at school.
