SUBJECT: APPROPRIATION OF STATE OF ALASKA LEGISLATIVE GRANT
FUNDS - SENATE BILLS 221 and 256

ASD Goal: *Ensure public accountability through effective consultation with community to ensure wise use of financial resources and responsible construction and maintenance of facilities.*

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board accept from the State of Alaska grant appropriations funded by Senate Bills 221 and 256 in the total amount of \$4,815,500 (Attachments A and B).

PERTINENT FACTS:

During the Second Session of the Twenty-Fifth Legislature, the Alaska State Legislature approved Senate Bills 221 and 256, appropriating 79 grants to the Anchorage School District in the total amount of \$4,815,500.

All grants are appropriated through the State Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development to the Municipality of Anchorage on behalf of the District.

Assembly Resolution 2008-128 was approved by the Anchorage Assembly on June 24, 2008, accepting and appropriating 2008 State of Alaska Legislative Grants per Senate Bills 221 and 256.
