SUBJECT: REAPPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE MULTICULTURAL  
EDUCATION CONCERNS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

*ASD Goal: Education in the highly diverse ASD will be accessible, culturally responsive, supportive of students, and safe.*

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board reappoint Atisa Logo and Dan Loring to the Multicultural Education Concerns Advisory Committee (MECAC).

PERTINENT FACTS:

The Anchorage School Board has established one advisory committee to the School Board, and it is the Multicultural Education Concerns Advisory Committee (MECAC). Its primary purpose is to advise the School Board and the Superintendent on a regular basis regarding 1) the educational program as it relates to the education of minority students K-12 districtwide; 2) citizen involvement in school activities on minority educational issues; 3) specific minority community concerns; and 4) such matters with respect to the District-at-large as may be identified by the School Board or the Superintendent. There are other issues of importance for the Multicultural Education Concerns Advisory Committee (MECAC) as outlined in the Guidelines.

Ms. Logo began serving on the MECAC in August 2002 and Mr. Loring joined the committee in October 2005. Both have been enthusiastic, dedicated members of the committee through the years. MECAC guidelines state that members are appointed for two-year terms. At their November 19, 2009 meeting, the committee voted to reappoint both people for additional two-year terms.
