SUBJECT: FIRST AND SECOND SEMESTER
SUSPENSION/WEAPONS/EXPULSION REPORT 2009-2010

ASD Goal: The achievement gap between racial, ethnic and economic groups in the highly diverse ASD will be eliminated through education that is accessible, culturally responsive, supportive of students and safe.

PERTINENT FACTS:

Discipline information for the 2009-2010 school year was collected and reported in a semester format due to the implementation of the new student information system, ZANGLE, and changes to state requirements for reporting discipline issues. Year-to-year comparisons of categories are not available. The reports regarding suspensions and expulsions for various incident types are collected from the elementary, middle, high, and charter schools for second semester and are shown in attachments A-F.

The school board requested information on the **percentage of students not suspended or expelled during a quarter**. That information is shown below:

High Schools

There were four **findings of causality** for high school students during the first semester of the 2009-2010 school year and one during the second semester. There were nine incidents involving weapons/firearms during the first semester of the 2009-2010 school year and five during the second semester. Eighteen high school students were expelled during the first semester and 30 during second semester. The highest numbers of second semester suspensions were in the categories of drugs-street (135) and willful disobedience (125).
