SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF A PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR
PEGGY ROBINSON-WILSON, SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve a Personal Services Contract between the Anchorage School District and School Board member Peggy Robinson-Wilson.

PERTINENT FACTS:

School Board member Peggy Robinson-Wilson had previously approached the Anchorage School Board (June 8, 1998 regarding ASD Memorandum #349) to inform them of her intention to work through the University of Alaska Anchorage to provide instructional services to teachers employed by the Anchorage School District. At the time this information was made available, Ms. Robinson-Wilson was under the belief that her teaching duties, provided through Anchorage School District's instructional technology department, were contracted by the Community and Technology College at UAA. (Her previous employment with this entity had demonstrated this relationship.) When the School Board initially heard Ms. Robinson-Wilson's statement, they were not required to approve her indirect working relationship with the District. Ms. Robinson-Wilson's intent and obligation was to inform them of her employment status and its relationship with the Anchorage School District.

The request for approval of a Personal Services Contract for her stems from a recognized change in the status of Ms. Robinson-Wilson's employment. The services provided and the remuneration due Ms. Robinson-Wilson have changed. She will now be reimbursed for her services through the Anchorage School District's Technology Literacy Challenge Grant.

Ms. Robinson-Wilson is eligible for a Personal Services Contract with the Anchorage School District in accordance with Anchorage School Board Policy 725.222 and AMC Sec. 1.15.170. Ms. Robinson-Wilson has addressed the disclosure component by filing a notice with the Municipality and by placing an ad in the Anchorage Daily News, see Attachment. The request for a Personal Services Contract from Ms. Robinson-Wilson to the School Board is forwarded with a recommendation for approval from the Administration.

It is the Administration's position that Ms. Robinson-Wilson be reimbursed for past services rendered and to continue providing instruction as identified in the Personal Services Contract.
