SUBJECT: MINORITY EDUCATION CONCERNS COMMITTEE
APPOINTMENT

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board appoint Rosalie Sandoval to the Minority Education Concerns Committee for a one year term.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The Anchorage School Board has established one advisory committee to the Board. This committee is the Minority Education Concerns Committee (MECC) and the primary purpose is to advise the School Board and the Superintendent on a regular basis regarding: 1) the educational program as it relates to the education of minority students K-12 Districtwide; 2) citizen involvement in school activities on minority educational issues; 3) specific minority community concerns; and 4) such other matters with respect to the District at-large as may be identified by the Board or the Superintendent. There are other issues of importance for the Minority Education Concerns Committee (MECC) as outlined in the Guidelines.

The School Board appointed six individuals to the MECC in March.

Interviews were conducted over the past two weeks by Bettye Davis, School Board member/MECC Board Liaison, John Alexander, Director EEO/AA, and Bob Christal, Superintendent, for four additional applicants. Further interviews will be conducted over the next month and advertisements will continue also. A copy of the application form is included for the candidate.
