

MINUTES OF THE ANCHORAGE SCHOOL BOARD

SPECIAL MEETING OF FEBRUARY 16, 1999

The Anchorage School Board met in Special Session on Tuesday, February 16, 1999, at 4:30 p.m. in the Board Room, at the Anchorage School District Administration Building. Vice President Peggy Robinson-Wilson presided.

B. PUBLIC HEARING ON COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT

1. ACE (Anchorage Council of Education)

Bob Christal announced that this was the first opportunity under the new law for the public to provide comment on the ACE collective bargaining agreement.

Theresa Obermeyer questioned why there was a paid advertisement in the newspaper for these negotiations since the Municipality did not publicize similar meetings. She pointed out that the law doesn't seem to be followed across the board and expressed concern with the Municipality not following the public meeting laws. Ms. Obermeyer commented that she supported ACE employees.

Peggy Robinson-Wilson read the opening paragraph from a letter submitted by the Anchorage Council of PTAs relative to general concerns about employee behavior during the Totem strike.
