SUBJECT: SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERSHIP IN ASSOCIATION OF ALASKA  
SCHOOL BOARDS

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the School Board authorize payment of \$23,800 to the Association of Alaska School Boards for membership for 1999.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The Anchorage School Board has participated in the Association of Alaska School Boards for several years. The Anchorage School Board recently met with the Executive Board of the Association of Alaska School Boards to discuss concerns and to offer ways for both groups to work together in positive, productive ways. The Association's Executive Board was receptive to discussing the items brought forth by the Anchorage School Board.

It is important for education policy groups across the State to understand the needs of both rural and urban school districts. In addition, because of the transiency of students today, many students move among school districts during their public school careers. Both the Association's Executive Board and the Anchorage School Board indicated an interest in continuing the cooperation and collaboration needed to support students across the State of Alaska.

The Administration will identify the source to fund the membership dues during the development of the first quarter budget transfer report.
