SUBJECT: DISTRICT AND SCHOOL REPORT CARDS

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board authorize the Superintendent to forward the enclosed ***School District Report Card to the Public: 1997-98 School Year*** and ***Educational Plan: 1998-99 School Year*** to the Department of Education in fulfillment of the requirements of the School Report Card legislation, AS Sec. 14.03.120(e).

PERTINENT FACTS:

Alaska Statute AS Sec. 12.03.120(e) requires that each school and school District in the state annually perform a planning and reporting process with their various communities. In Anchorage, individual schools are asked to annually prepare a set of three to five goals in the fall of the year and report to their communities, and then to the District, the school's performances relative to those goals and on other measures required in the legislation. The plans for the schools must be developed by September 30 of each year and a public meeting providing a report back to the public must be completed by the end of May.

The District is also required to annually develop a plan for the year and to report to the public, and then to the State, progress toward meeting the goals in the plan and also to provide other information as required in the legislation or by the State Department of Education. This reporting must be completed by October 31, annually.

The individual schools in Anchorage have completed their Report Cards for 1997-98 and their School Plans for 1998-99. The submission of the enclosed reports to the State Department of Education will complete the requirement for the District as well.
