SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR NOVEMBER
30, 1998

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for November 30, 1998 is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of November was 49,370, an increase of 828 students over the November 26, 1997 total of 48,542. Table 1 compares the membership on November 30, 1998 with the totals from November 26, 1997.

The November 30, 1998 total of 49,370 was 181 less than the beginning of the year September 30, 1998 total of 49,551. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 251 for the same time period during the 1997-98 school year, and an average decline of 93 for the 29-year historical average since the 1970-71 school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is attached. There are five elementary schools at or above 120 percent of their program capacity. Muldoon was added to the listing for November and Ptarmigan was removed.

One secondary program, SAVE I, has an active enrollment that is at or above 120 percent of program capacity. There were no changes from the October 1998 listing.
