SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR DECEMBER  
1998

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for December 22, 1998 is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of December was 48,952, an increase of 641 students over the December 19, 1997 total of 48,321. Table 1 compares the membership on December 22, 1998 with the totals from December 19, 1997.

The December 22, 1998 total of 48,952 was 599 less than the beginning of the year September 30, 1998 total of 59,551. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 482 for the same time period (September through December) during the 1997-98 school year, and an average decline of 326 for the 29-year historical average since the 1970-71 school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is attached. There are five elementary schools, the same as last or above 120 percent of their program capacity. There were no changes from the November 1998 listing.

One secondary program, SAVE I, has an active enrollment at or above 120 percent of program capacity. There were no changes from the November 1998 listing.
