SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR JANUARY
1999

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for January 29, 1999 is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of January was 49,318, an increase of 821 students over the January 30, 1998 total of 48,497. Table 1 compares the membership on January 29, 1999 with the totals from January 30, 1998.

The January 29, 1999 total of 49,318 was 233 less than the beginning of the year September 30, 1998 total of 49,551. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 296 for the same time period (September through January) during the 1997-98 school year, and an average decline of 233 (September through January) for the 29-year historical average since the 1970-71 school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is attached. There are five elementary schools at or above 120 percent of their program capacity. There were no changes from the previous month.

One secondary school, SAVE I, has an active enrollment, which is at or above 120 percent of its program capacity. There were no changes from the previous month.
