PERTINENT FACTS:

The 1999 Alaska State Science and Engineering Fair was held on March 27. Anchorage School District students did very well in the competition, earning many grand prize awards in main categories and many top awards in secondary categories.

Romig Middle School did especially well, winning four main category grand prize awards. Romig students also won 20 first-place awards and 40 other awards.

Romig's grand prize winners were:

- Erica Rothman in Gerontology,
- Emily Phillips in Physics,
- Dezi Rae Robb in Botany, and
- Mara Rosenthal and Catherine Steele in the Team category.

For their overall school performance, Romig Middle School was named the science fair's top middle school. This is the third time in the last five years that Romig students have brought home this coveted trophy.

It is requested that the School Board recognize Romig Middle School as the 1999 Alaska State Science and Engineering Fair's best overall middle school.
