SUBJECT: END-OF-YEAR MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR 1998-99

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-year membership report for June 4, 1999 is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of the 1998-99 school year was 48,102, an increase of 542 students over the 1997-98 end-of-year total of 47,560. Table 1 compares the membership on June 4, 1999 with the totals from June 2, 1998.

The end-of-year total of 48,102 was 1,449 less than the September 30, 1998 total of 49,551. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 1,233 for the September 30 to end-of-year time period for the 1997-98 school year, and an average decline of 1,212 for the 29-year historical average (September to end-of-year) since the 1970-71 school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is attached. There are seven elementary schools at or above 120 percent of their program capacity. One elementary schools, Kasuun, was added to the end-of-year list.

There were no secondary schools or programs at or above 120 percent of program capacity at the close of the 1998-99 school year.
