RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve the HIV/AIDS Prevention - RARE-T Continuation Grant in the amount of \$25,000.00 from the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services.

PERTINENT FACTS:

A proposal was submitted to the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services in April 1999 for a total of \$40,041.00 to provide continued support for the Reduce AIDS Risk Effectively in Teens (RARE-T) HIV/AIDS peer education project.

On June 14, 1999, \$25,000 was awarded to support the on-going training of students and advisors; dissemination of the program through classroom presentations in the ASD and trainings in other communities; sub-release time for advisors to attend presentations; and skit and brochure development. The budget for the project includes:
