SUBJECT: DISTRICT AND SCHOOL REPORT CARDS

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that School Board authorize the Superintendent to submit the enclosed School District Report Card to the Public: 1998-99 and the Educational Plan 1999-2000 School Year to the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development in compliance with Alaska Statute Sec. 14.03.120 (a) (c) (e).

PERTINENT FACTS:

Attachment A provides the School District Report Card to the Public: 1998-99 for the Anchorage School District. Attachment B provides the Educational Plan 1999-2000 School Year for the District. These documents were developed and compiled to meet the requirements of Alaska Statute Section 14.03.120 (a) (c) (e). This statute is generally referred to as the "School Report Card Law."

In addition to the Report Card presented in Attachment A, the District will be providing its Profile of Performance: 1998-99 and the newspaper supplement, "Telling Our Story" to the State Department as part of the report card package.

The goals presented in the Educational Plan (Attachment B) are in draft form, reflecting an initial interpretation of the discussion at the Work Session on Goals that was held on Monday, October 18, 1999. There is more work to be done before submitting these to the School Board in November. The transmittal letter to the State Department will make it clear that the goals as presented are in draft form and may change during final review and ratification in November, but that the general intent and direction specified by the draft goals is likely to remain constant.

Also, in addition to the District level Report Card and Educational Plan, each school has developed a unit level Report Card to the Public for 1998-99 and a School Action Plan for 1999-2000. These documents are available for review at the individual schools or through the Executive Directors of the various school divisions (Elementary, Middle School, High School, Special Education). The documents for the Charter Schools in the District are available through the individual schools or through the Office of the Assistant Superintendent of Instruction.
