SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR JANUARY 2000

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for January 31, 2000 is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of January was 49,058, a decrease of 260 students from the January 29, 1999 total of 49,318. Table 1 compares the membership on January 31, 2000 with the totals from January 29, 1999.

The January 31, 2000 total of 49,058 was 254 less than the beginning of the year September 30, 1999 total of 49,312. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 233 for the same time period (September through January) during the 1998-99 school

year, and an average decline of 246 (September through January) for the 10-year historical average since the 1990-91 school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is attached. There are four elementary schools at or above 120 percent of their program capacity. There were no changes from the previous month.

One secondary school, SAVE I, has an active enrollment that is at or above 120 percent of its program capacity. There were no changes from the previous month.
