SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR
MARCH, 2000

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for March 31, 2000 is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of March was 48,714, a decrease of 107 students from the March 31, 1999 total of 48,821. Table 1 compares the membership on March 31, 2000 with the totals from March 31, 1999.

The March 31, 2000 total of 48,714 was 598 less than the beginning of the year September 30, 1999 total of 49,312. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 730 for the same time period (September through March) during the 1998-99 school year, and an average decline of 571 (September through March) for the 10-year historical average since the 1990-91 school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is attached. There are three elementary schools at or above 120 percent of their program capacity. There were no changes to the elementary school listing for March.

There is one secondary school, Save I, at or above 120 percent of program capacity. McLaughlin Secondary was removed from the listing for March.
