SUBJECT: GRANT APPLICATION: ALASKA EARLY INTERVENTION
HEARING RESOURCE

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve and authorize the Superintendent to submit the Alaska Early Intervention Hearing Resource grant application for FY2000-2001. The total budget amount for this grant application is \$166,734.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The purpose of the Alaska Early Intervention Hearing Resource is to provide appropriate early educational services to families with children between the ages of birth and three years who live in the state of Alaska. These children must have a hearing loss or are at high risk for a hearing loss. The primary purpose is to intervene as early as possible on behalf of hearing impaired infants. Intervention is designed to minimize or prevent developmental delays resulting from hearing loss. This includes a strong family support and training model.

A requirement of the grant is for the District to provide in-kind services. A total of \$74,838 is spent for in-kind contribution. This includes facilities support and instructional support from the ASSDHH state grant.

The following is a breakdown of the budget for Early Intervention Hearing Resource.
