SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF A PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR  
PEGGY ROBINSON, SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve a Personal Services Contract between the Anchorage School District and School Board member Peggy Robinson.

PERTINENT FACTS:

When the School Board approved the Technology Challenge Grant (ASD Memorandum #192) on February 14, 2000, Board member Peggy Robinson gave notice of the potential of her teaching one or more classes being offered through this grant. At that time, Ms. Robinson did not have any agreement with the Instructional Technology Department for specific courses or dates. Subsequent to that meeting, Ms. Robinson has entered into an agreement to teach a few classes to be paid for by the Technology Challenge Grant. These classes are offered during this summer to teachers in both Anchorage and other school districts.

Ms. Robinson is eligible for a Personal Services Contract with the Anchorage School District in accordance with Anchorage School Board Policy 725.222 and AMC Sec. 1.15.170. Ms. Robinson has addressed the disclosure component by filing a notice with the Municipality and by placing an ad in the Journal of Commerce. The request for a Personal Services Contract from Ms. Robinson to the School Board is forwarded with a recommendation for approval from the Administration.

The Anchorage School Board previously approved a similar contract on August 24, 1998.
