RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board authorize the Superintendent to accept additional Youth in Detention grant funding from the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development in the amount of \$121,780. This additional funding for McLaughlin School's Youth In Detention Grant was awarded for the 1999-2000 school year.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The additional Youth In Detention Grant funds will be used to update McLaughlin School technology and to supplement funding for the McLaughlin Summer School Program. Our recently completed ten-year Northwest Evaluation Report recommends an extended summer program.

This grant does not require a cash match from the Anchorage School District, and does not include release time. Personnel items are for contract addenda for McLaughlin staff.
