SUBJECT: END-OF-YEAR MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR 1999-2000

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-year membership report for June 5, 2000 is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of the 1999-2000 school year was 48,276, an increase of 174 students over the 1998-99 end-of-year total of 48,102. Table 1 compares the membership on June 5, 2000 with the totals from June 3, 1999.

The end-of-year total of 48,276 was 1,036 less than the beginning-of-year September 30, 1999 total of 49,551. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 1,449 for the September 30 to end-of-year time period for the 1998-99

school year, and an average decline of 1,230 for the 10-year historical average (September to end-of-year) since the 1990-91 school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is attached. There are three elementary schools at or above 120 percent of their program capacity. There were no additions or deletions to the listing since April 2000.

There is one secondary school (SAVE) at or above 120 percent of its program capacity. There were no additions or deletions to the listing this month.
