SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF CONTINUATION GRANT AWARD: HIV/AIDS PREVENTION

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board authorize the Superintendent to accept a continuation grant award in the amount of \$25,000 from the State of Alaska, Department of Health and Social Services, for an existing HIV/AIDS prevention project.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The Anchorage School District (ASD) applied for and won continuation funds from the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services, Division of Public Health, to fund the RARE-T HIV/AIDS Peer Education program for the period of July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001. This grant is one of several offered by the State as part of its HIV/AIDS Prevention Program. It is a continuation of funding first awarded by the State in FY 1999-2000 to support the existing ASD RARE-T program. The RARE-T HIV/AIDS Peer Education Program in Anchorage provides training to student peer educators which enables them to offer training and presentations to their peers on the dangers associated with risk-taking behaviors which could lead to HIV/AIDS infection.
