SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION OF ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR
GOLDENVIEW MIDDLE SCHOOL SEWER MAINTENANCE

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board authorize additional funding in the amount of \$50,000 for completing the Goldenview Middle School sewer project to AWWU standards.

PERTINENT FACTS:

AWWU has not accepted the sewer line constructed by the District that services Goldenview Middle School. AWWU has identified manholes that were previously inspected and tentatively approved, but which recent inspections now show, have additional deficiencies. It will cost approximately \$50,000 to correct these deficiencies. Funding is available for transfer into this project from '94 G.O. Bond restricted interest earnings.

It is important to complete this work prior to winter freeze-up and turn the sewer over to AWWU for two reasons. First, as developer, the District must provide a two-year warranty on the construction and maintenance of the sewer lines, and the sooner the lines are turned over, the sooner this two-year commitment can end. Secondly, once the sewer lines have been accepted by AWWU, the District will be able to collect from AWWU a portion of the upsizing costs associated with the project. The agreement with AWWU for reimbursement of the upsizing costs requires that the lines be complete and finally accepted by AWWU before the District is eligible for reimbursement.
