SUBJECT: AASB BOARD OF DIRECTORS NOMINATION

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board nominate Debbie Ossiander for a seat on the Association of Alaska School Boards (AASB) Board of Directors.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The Association of Alaska School Boards is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of 15 members elected at large from throughout the state. To qualify for a seat on the Board, a nominee must be a member of a Board of Education in good standing with the Association.

The criteria for selection includes demonstrated leadership and experience, a perspective and vision of the future for school boards, adaptability, and time available to devote to AASB Board service.

Aside from expected participation in AASB activities, members of the Board of Directors establish policies that supervise, control and direct the business of AASB. Adopting and maintaining a Board Policy Manual, which sets forth procedures and guidelines for the Board's operations, is also a corporate duty of selected individuals.

Members of the AASB Board of Directors are governed by a strict code of ethics and are considered ambassadors for the Association. Debbie Ossiander's proven dedication to fulfilling her role and responsibilities as a member of the Anchorage School Board is apparent. As a current member of the AASB Board of Directors, it is evident that Ms. Ossiander cares about the educational welfare of Alaska's public school students and is committed to improving education.
