SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT AWARD: STATEWIDE WIA  
SCHOOL YOUTH PROGRAM

RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board authorize the Superintendent to accept a grant award from the State of Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development, in the amount of \$24,112.

PERTINENT FACTS:

Workforce Investment Act (WIA) funds are available to the Anchorage School District for providing vocational assessment, pre-employment skills development, and occupational skills training for youth from McLaughlin School. The goal is to prepare students for specific postsecondary training and careers upon graduation from high school. A follow-up project extends support services to June 30, 2002. Grant funds will provide salary and benefits for added duty pay for a coordinator/evaluator, case manager, and teacher assistant. Funds will also provide wages and benefits for twelve youth participants. The grant does not require release time or matching funds.
