SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT AWARD: SCI TECH TO CAREER

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board authorize the Superintendent to accept a grant from the Alaska Business Education Compact in the amount of \$5,500.

PERTINENT FACTS:

McLaughlin Secondary School applied for a grant from the Alaska Business Education Compact to expand and enhance McLaughlin's SciTech curriculum. McLaughlin staff will continue to incorporate science, food science, language arts, math, and social studies into the SciTech curriculum; infuse school to career concepts and activities into SciTech; and will align this course of studies with Alaska standards in the core content areas.

The grant budget covers release time for three teachers to come together to plan the curriculum enhancements, at one day each; science laboratory supplies; and such laboratory equipment as centrifuge, distillation equipment, and electronic balances. In-kind contributions include materials and equipment that are part of the regular program, and volunteer time from community partners in science industries.
