SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF SCHEMATIC DESIGN FOR BARTLETT HIGH SCHOOL PHASE I

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve the Schematic Design of Bartlett High School Phase I and authorize the Superintendent to proceed with the Design Development phase, pending Municipal Assembly approval of the schematic design.

PERTINENT FACTS:

In April 1999, the voters approved \$5 million in funding for the design and construction of Phase I for interior and exterior site improvements as part of a master plan to bring the facility into compliance with Districtwide high school educational specifications. The design is based on the Districtwide Educational Specifications adopted by the School Board in June 1998.

The School Board approved the selection of Kumin and Associates, Inc. to be the Architects of Record on May 9, 2000, ASD Memorandum #337 (1999-2000). The Municipal Assembly approved the selection of Kumin and Associates, Inc. on August 15, 2000 (AR No. 2000-223).

A series of public meetings have been held since June 1999. Participants have included the Building Design Committee, consisting of community representatives, parents, teachers and students that have assisted in development of the design.

Kumin and Associates, Inc. presented the Conceptual Design for School Board approval on June 12, 2000, ASD Memorandum #277 (2000-2001). The Municipal Assembly approved the Conceptual Design on August 29, 2000 (AR No. 2000-243).

Kumin and Associates, Inc. delivered the Schematic Design submittal package to the School District on October 6, 2000. Construction is anticipated to begin in spring 2001 with completion of the facility in 2004.

Bartlett High School, a 313,590 net square foot three story facility, delivers educational programs for grades 9 through 12, including a well-developed Intensive Needs program. It was built in 1972 and has had major upgrades of the roof system in 1999 and addition to the site of a swimming pool in 1987.
