SUBJECT: ANCHORAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
PROGRAM LEGISLATIVE REQUESTS

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve the attached Anchorage School District's Capital Improvement Program Legislative Request. The information will be made available to Legislators and other interested groups for funding consideration.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The Capital Improvement Program Legislative Requests was developed by the District management, with input from the School Board and principals, staff, parents, community councils and other interested parties. This document consists of four sections. The first section discusses the District's bond history and need for capital improvements. The second section presents the 2001 Bond proposal that will be presented to the Anchorage Assembly. The third section is a description of the projects in the Bond. The final part of the document is the District's Six-Year CIP for 2000-2006.

The District is not able to meet all critical facilities and maintenance needs through the District's operating budget alone. The District needs capital funds, through a combination of bonds, grants and debt reimbursement.
