SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR NOVEMBER
30, 2000

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for November 30, 2000 is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of November was 49,294, an increase of 306 students from the November 30, 1999 total of 48,988. Table 1 compares the membership on November 30, 2000 with the totals from November 30, 1999.

The November 30, 2000 total of 49,294 was 226 less than the beginning of the year September 30, 2000 total of 49,520. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 325 for the same time period during the 1999-2000 school year, and an average decline of 224 for the ten year historical average since the 1991-92 school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is attached. There are three elementary schools at or above 120 percent of their program capacity. Susitna Elementary School was added to the listing for November.

One secondary program, SAVE I, has an active enrollment that is at or above 120 percent of program capacity. There were no changes from the October 2000 secondary program listing.
