SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY
FOR DECEMBER 2000

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for December 15, 2000 is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of December was 49,190, a gain of 515 students from the December 21, 1999 total of 48,675. Table 1 compares the membership on December 15, 2000 with the totals from December 21, 1999.

The December 15, 2000 total of 49,190 was 330 less than the beginning of the year September 30, 2000 total of 49,520. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 637 for the same time period (September through December) during the 1999-2000 school year, and an average decline of 515 (September through December) for the ten year historical average since the 1991-1992 school year. It should be noted that elementary schools have increased by 102 students during the September through December time frame.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is attached. There are three elementary schools at or above 120 percent of their program capacity. There were no changes from the November 2000 listing.

One secondary program, SAVE I, has an active enrollment at or above 120 percent of program capacity. There were no changes from the November 2000 listing.
