SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR
FEBRUARY 2001

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for February 28, 2001, is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of February was 49,204, an increase of 159 students from the February 29, 2000, total of 49,045. Table 1 compares the membership on February 28, 2001, with the totals from February 29, 2000. The comparison and official membership for February 29, 2000, vs. February 28, 2001, is shown on Attachment A.

The February 28, 2001, total of 49,204 was 316 less than the beginning of the year September 30, 2000, total of 49,520. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 267 for the same time period (September through February) during the 1999-2000 school year, and an average decline of 392 (September through February) for the 10-year historical average since the 1991-92 school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is shown on Attachment B. There are three elementary schools at or above 120 percent of their program capacity. There were no changes from the previous month.

Pre-elementary, elementary, and secondary special education numbers are shown on Attachment C

One secondary school, SAVE I, has an active enrollment that is at or above 120 percent of its program capacity. There were no changes from the previous month.
