PERTINENT FACTS:

The Anchorage School District Safe and Drug-Free Schools program sponsored a two-day training in April on media literacy for high school students and community members. The event featured Bob McCannon, Executive Director of the New Mexico Media Literacy Project. The State Tobacco Prevention and Control Program was a partnering sponsor.

This contract award reimburses the Anchorage School District for part of the expenses of this training.

The contract does not include release time.
