SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR
MARCH 2001

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for March 30, 2001, is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of March was 48,946, an increase of 232 students from the total of 48,714 on March 31, 2000. Table 1 compares the membership on March 30, 2001, with the totals from March 31, 2000. The comparison and official membership for March 31, 2000, vs. March 30, 2001, is shown on Attachment A.

The March 30, 2001, total of 48,946 was 574 less than the beginning of the year September 30, 2000, total of 49,520. This decrease can be compared to a decline of 598 for the same time period (September through March) during the 1999-2000 school year, and an average decline of 607 (September through March) for the 10-year historical average since the 1991-92 school year. It should be noted that the elementary population has increased by 323 students since the beginning of this school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is shown on Attachment B. There are three elementary schools at or above 120 percent of their program capacity. There were no changes from the previous month.

Pre-elementary, elementary, and secondary special education numbers are shown on Attachment C.

One secondary school, SAVE I, has an active enrollment that is at or above 120 percent of its program capacity. There were no changes from the previous month.
